

Alcohol and Smoking Policy

No person under the age of 21 years old shall drink alcoholic beverages on church property or at any church function at any time.

Insurance regulations prohibit the sale of alcohol at events at Peoples without the purchase of a separate insurance policy.

Therefore:

- Alcohol may not be sold or provided at any event at Peoples which requires admission or payment for a meal.
- Alcohol may be consumed at potluck meals in the church building when a person brings their own alcohol. It may not be shared with anyone other than family members.
- Alcohol may be consumed at Peoples supported functions outside of Peoples church building provided the location is an establishment with a license to sell alcohol for on-site consumption. This license requires that they monitor the amount of alcohol consumed by an individual.
- Alcohol may not be consumed at Peoples supported functions outside of Peoples Church building if the location is not licensed to sell alcohol for on-site consumption.

Smoking is not allowed in the building. This includes all types of pipes, cigars, cigarettes and e-cigarettes. This shall not infringe upon use in any religious ceremony.
