

Peoples Church UU - Service Animal, Support Animal, and Pet Policy

Service animals, defined as an animal that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability and licensed by the ADA, are always allowed in Peoples Church.

“Emotional support animals” are allowed in the building as long as the animal has at least basic behavior training. This includes but is not limited to: they must not bark, bite, jump up, growl or show any signs of aggression toward others, they will stand or sit by the owner at all times, and they will signal their owner when they need to relieve themselves.

Trained and well-behaved pets, who meet the behavior conditions described above for support animals, are only allowed in the building with the prior consent of everyone who will be in the room.

All dogs in the building must be on a leash in common areas.

Any animal, service animal or not, who is disruptive may be required to leave with its owner.
