Faith Formation on Bad Weather Days

When Sunday morning in-person events are cancelled, we will institute the following plan of action for our Faith Formation time.

The Director of Faith Formation will have two backup options planned in advance to prepare for inclement weather. The first option will be continuing the Faith Formation classes for children and youth on the Zoom platform from 9:45-10:45am. Volunteer leaders will be given an adjusted lesson that better suits an online learning environment. The second option will be an at home lesson that will be sent out to families that morning. This lesson is designed to allow families to do the Faith Formation time together at their home. If inclement weather happens on a Sunday where the Director of Faith Formation is taking the day off, then only the second option will be offered to families and the online Zoom lesson will be canceled for the day.
