

#### **Ministerial Search Team Update for November**

Hello and happy autumn to all you lovely people.

First of all, welcome Charles Cizio to the Search Team! We are glad to have him join us.

Second, you may have already seen the **brief** congregational survey update we distributed in October, which can be found at <u>tinyurl.com/pcuu2022</u>. This short survey consists of only **three questions** to help us understand where we are as a congregation in our second year of search.

If you submitted a response in October, thank you so much! If you weren't able and would still like to share your thoughts, feel free to fill out the survey now. Just go to <a href="mailto:tinyurl.com/pcuu2022">tinyurl.com/pcuu2022</a>.

So what's next?

- 1. We submit to the Transitions Office the revised Congregational Record that reflects your responses to the survey update. That will go live on December 1, when UU ministerial candidates will be able to review openings across the country.
- 2. We spread the word about our opportunity to ministers beyond the UUA who may be interested in joining our congregation. Rest assured that we will cast a selective net focused on liberal leaning groups.
- 3. Applicants submit their materials by the end of December.

We review applicants in the beginning of January to identify the best candidate for Peoples Church.

Two important reminders:

The discernment process of moving from applicant to candidate takes many weeks and many conversations.

The Search Team cannot share any information about applicants to our position until we have identified our candidate.

We will continue to provide regular updates during the process, but we cannot share any information about the number of applicants, who they are, where they are located, or even their gender pronouns. We appreciate your understanding.



After this last round of feedback they will write the final draft which they will present to UUA's board in January, and it will be put to a vote at the 2023 General Assembly. 

The Finance Team met on 10/20/22 to review financial reports and discuss financial planning for the future.

Cash flow was positive for the first three (3) quarters of 2022 (January through September):

- January through September income \$173,382
- January through September expenses \$164,167

#### Van Vechten Guild

Meeting Monday, November 14 at noon—BYOL. The speaker this month will be from Trees Forever.

The Peoples Church solar electric (photovoltaic) system has now been producing electricity for a full year. If you recall before we installed solar we replaced inefficient lights and HVAC with more efficient ones.



In September 2022 we asked Alliant to turn off the parking lot flood light that cost \$30 a month, or \$360 a year.

Charlie Cizio supplied the info below:

We produced 21,000 kilowatt hours of electricity.

In the full year before we installed the photovoltaics our electric bill was \$3047.

In the year since adding them our bill was \$717, including about \$300 for the flood light that has now gone away, giving us a monthly electricity cost of around \$45 or so. That will change some due to weather and anticipated Alliant rate increases.

Thanks to all who helped make the solar project possible. Remember you may be able to substantially reduce your utility costs by embracing efficient technologies.
