- 1. Call to Order at 7:02 p.m. Board President Steve Hershner

- 2. Lighting of the Chalice Rev. Carin, with a reading on pluralism by Elizabeth Gilbert Board Check-in on personal experiences with pluralism
- **3. Approve Minutes** from April 24, 2024 Board meeting *Motion by Sue, second by Cate; unanimously approved.*
- 4. Reports
  - a. Minister's report:
    - The April 27 Installation Ceremony was memorable and deeply appreciated;
    - The **Coming of Age** worship service wrapped up the Faith Formation year
    - Little Banned Book Library reveal celebrated and covered by local media
    - Media tech is preparing for Jackie Wedeking's departure June 6; Matt Wilde will assume primary role with support of member volunteers, relying on the manual created by Jackie. Continue to build volunteer training and depth.
